 - Be permanently appointed to a permanent careers adviser teaching position (minimum 0.6 FTE) and be currently undertaking, or planning to enrol in the next semester, in an approved postgraduate qualification in teacher librarianship, career education or EAL/D or TESOL.
- Be willing to enter into a Scholarship Agreement, a legally binding agreement that outlines the responsibilities of both the scholarship recipient and the department.
- Be willing to complete the required studies within the agreed time frame specified as part of your conditions of permanent employment.
- Be willing to remain in your current permanent full-time teaching position following completion of studies for a minimum period of three years.
