Application Fee: \$400 + GST (non-refundable)

Tuition Fee (GST Free)

- The Tuition Fee is invoiced 1 week after the commencement of the course.
- Payment due dates are stated in your initial invoice, due months 1, 4, 7 & 12.
- Each payment must be paid within 14 days, as stated in the initial invoice.
- Payments can be made via credit card or EFTPOS.
