Skills First is a Victorian Government program that helps people access vocational education and training. If you are eligible, you can apply for a government-subsidised place, and if approved the government will contribute a portion of your tuition fees.

Student Commitment

Students must:

1. Actively participate and meet the requirements of 'Evidence of Participation' for each unit in the course every 30 days by a combination of the following:
 - ▶ Attending scheduled tutorials
 - ▶ Submitting assessment booklets by the due date
 - ▶ Completing activities and quizzes on the Learning Management System
 - ▶ Conversing and engaging with the course trainer

2. Attend all compulsory scheduled workshops

*Failure to meet these requirements may result in funding being withdrawn.

Eligibility



Australian or NZ Citizen

You must be an Australian citizen, a holder of a permanent visa or a New Zealand citizen



Victorian Resident

You must undertake all training and assessment whilst being physically present in the State of Victoria or in one of the below approved border region postcodes



Other Requirements

You must not be enrolled in more than two Skills First funded courses in a year or more than two Skills First funded courses at a time
